

## WASHINGTON COUNTY JR. FAIR BOARD

The purpose of the Washington County Jr. Fair Board is to provide young adults with an opportunity to develop leadership skills, perform community service and become aware of the business and operations of the fair.

### APPLICATION PROCESS

1. Members shall be selected by submitting a completed application to the Washington County Fair Board of Directors. The Board of Directors will choose whether each applicant is approved.
2. Members must return the signed terms along with their application.
3. Each member must reside in or attend a school in Washington County or be a member of a Washington County 4-H Club.
4. Jr. Fair Board Members must be between the ages of 18-28 at the time of application.

**Applications are due to the Fair Board no later than March 31, 2026. Applications can be submitted in person at the Fair Board Meeting (March 9, 2026 @ 6:30pm) or emailed to [washfair@yahoo.com](mailto:washfair@yahoo.com) (Please put Jr. Board Application in subject line when sending.)**

1. Members will serve a 12-month term beginning in April of 2026. The term will run concurrently to when the Annual Fair Board meeting is held each January.
2. Members must apply each year.
3. All members must be age 18-28 and reside in Washington County, attend school in Washington County, or be in a 4-H Club in Washington County.
4. The Jr. Fair Board will report to the chairperson from the Board of Directors.
5. The Jr. Fair Board will elect officers (President, Vice-President, and Secretary) at the beginning of each term.
6. Jr. Fair Board Members are encouraged to attend regular Fair Board Meetings.
7. Jr. Fair Board Members may present ideas to the Board of Directors at all regular board meetings.
8. Members are required to attend at least 6 Jr. Fair Board Meetings per year.
9. A member of the Board of Directors must be present at each Jr. Fair Board Meeting.
10. All Jr. Fair Board Members are representatives of the Washington County Fair Association. Therefore, the Board of Directors has the right to remove any Jr. Fair Board Member for actions that do not positively represent the fair.
11. The Jr. Fair Board Member agrees to meet the following service requirements.
  - a. Complete a minimum of 10 hours of service to the fair during the year, outside of the fair.
  - b. Help with at least 1 fundraising/community event the fair hosts/participates in during the year, outside of the actual fair.
  - c. Will work at least 2 (a minimum of 10 hours for the week) days during the week of the Fair with any event or project that needs completed for the Fair.
